**M. Sc. (Comp. Sci.) Admission 2018-19**

**Admission Procedure**

1. For admission to M.Sc. (Comp. Sci.) the Entrance examination conducted by the college is compulsory.
2. The admissions will be based on merit list.
  - a) The merit list of candidates, who have completed B.Sc. (Comp. Sci.) **from SPPU**, will be based on:
    - i) The score obtained in the entrance test (50% weightage)
    - ii) Marks obtained in qualifying examination (B.Sc.(Comp. Sci.)-Principal Total))- (50% weightage).
  - b) The merit list of candidates, who are **from universities other than SPPU**, will be prepared on the basis of score in the Entrance Examination only.
3. After the declaration of the results of the qualifying examination (B.Sc.(Comp. Sci)) the Candidates will have to submit the true copy of their mark list.  
**This must be done within 3 days of declaration of result by SPPU.**
4. The merit list of students who qualify for admission to M.Sc.( Comp. Sci.) Course will be displayed on the College Notice Board and on the College Web-Site.
5. Along with the merit list the schedule for provisional admission to M.Sc.(Comp. Sci.) Course will be displayed.
6. A counseling session will be organized in the Principal's Office as per the dates displayed in the provisional admission schedule. Candidate should report 15 minutes before the beginning of the counseling session. Otherwise the candidate will not be considered for admission.
7. At the time of the counseling session the physical presence of the student is an absolute must. Claim for admission due to absence at the counseling session will not be entertained under any circumstances.
8. At the time of counseling, if candidate is offered admission, and if he/she accepts the offer, then he/she will be guided regarding further admission process to be followed.

9. At the time of provisional admission and counseling candidate should carry:
  - a. Original & true copy of B. Sc. (Comp. Sci.) mark list.
  - b. Original & true copies of 10th and 12th Standard examinations.
  - c. Certificate to prove date of birth.
  - d. Aadhar Card.
  - e. Bank account details.
  - f. (if applicable) original caste certificate, non-creamy layer certificate, caste validation certificate.
  
10. In case of a tie at the entrance exam marks, marks obtained in the principal subject will be considered.
  
11. A candidate, who accepts the offered provisional admission must have to pay Rs. 5,000/- immediately by cash paid through challan in the bank or by DD.
  
12. Remaining fees have to be paid within **two** days of the provisional admission. Failure to do so within the stipulated time frame will result in the candidate losing claim over the admission and the Rs. 5,000/- paid earlier will not be refunded. The seat will then be allotted to the next eligible candidate.
  
13. Remaining fees can be paid by cash through challan in the bank or by DD.
  
14. Provisional admission does not imply confirmation of admission. Admission will only be confirmed after the candidate submits all necessary documents and makes the payment of complete fees within next **two** days.
  
15. The process of Admission will stop as and when all available seats are filled up.
